



Thank you for scheduling an appointment with Dermatology & Laser Center of Charleston. To better help you prepare for your appointment, we have created a brief checklist of items to bring along with you.

If you have any questions about the items below, please do not hesitate to contact our office for further explanation.

Items to Bring to Your Initial Consultation at DLCC:

- **Photo ID** – A drivers license, passport or school ID are all acceptable forms.
- **Insurance Card(s)** – We will not be able to see you without your insurance card. Please verify with your insurance carrier, prior to your appointment, that Dermatology and Laser Center of Charleston providers are listed in your network. *If you are insured by someone other than yourself, please have the card holder's date of birth and social security number in order to ensure proper filing.
- **Completed Paperwork** – We encourage you to fill this out online before arriving for your appointment to speed the check-in process. If you are unable to do so, please arrive no later than 30 minutes prior to your appointment time to fill out the necessary forms.

Suggested Items and Information to Bring to Your Initial Consultation at DLCC:

- **Clean Face and Nails** – Before beginning your Full Body Skin Exam, you will be asked to remove any makeup or lotions from your face. This may also be applicable for any acne evaluations or evaluating other concerns occurring on the face. As skin cancer and additional conditions can also be identified by a person's nails, we ask for you to remove all nail polish prior to your appointment as well.
- **Prior Medical Records** – Do you have records from a previous Dermatologist you would like to have sent to our office? Please contact our office at (843) 556-8886 and ask for our Medical Records Department.
- **Family Skin Cancer History** – Does your family have a history of skin cancer? Knowing the type of skin cancer (i.e. Basal Cell Carcinoma, Squamous Cell Carcinoma, Melanoma) of family members will help complete your medical history.
- **Pathology Reports** – Have you had skin cancer? Obtaining a copy of the pathology reports associated with these lesions, or any such biopsy you have had in the past, is a great asset to continuing your dermatological care. If you are unsure on how to obtain a copy of these reports, please contact our office for assistance.
